All the class of Dunham Dark, a dry hint of cherry that cuts through.	
<u>EAST LONDON BREWERY</u> (Leyton London 2011)	
QUADRANT OATMEAL STOUT	5.8
A smooth oatmeal stout with a silky mouth feel, rich dark fruit flavour and hints of coffee.	
<u>FULL MOON</u> (Battle East Sussex 2008)	
HOPDANCE	3.9
A dry, golden ale with a fresh fruit and citrus hop aroma, combining three different hops in American portions with light and crystal malts to give a unique golden ale with depth of flavour.	
<u>GOODY ALES</u> (Herne Kent 2012)

A pale golden coloured, floral bitter.	
<u>HOP FUZZ</u> (Hythe Kent 2011)	
HAWAIIAN	3.8
American ale, brewed with some of the fruitiest American hops and rich caramel malts, this IPA is a light bodied and pineapple tasting IPA.

Golden coloured traditional tasting ale, using East Kent Golding's hops. Balanced beer that leaves a smooth mouth feel and pleasant malt taste.

Dark & refreshing with a distinctive chocolate malt flavour and smooth hoppy finish.

<u>HELMSMAN</u>	4.2
Pale ale with full malt flavour and delicate hop balance.	
<u>PURPLE MOOSE</u> (Porthmadog Gwyned 2002)	
<u>GLASLYN</u>	4.2
Golden fruity best bitter, well balanced hoppy finish.	
<u>SNOWDONIA</u>	3.6
Refreshing Pale ale brewed with a combination of aromatic hops.	
<u>RIDGESIDE</u> (Leeds Yorkshire 2010)	
<u>LAST HORIZON</u>	3.5
Pale hopped with American Cascade and Centennial hops.	
<u>RINGWAY</u> (Stockport Lancashire 2012)	
<u>SESSION</u>	3.8
Golden session beer.	
<u>RIPPLE STEAM</u> (Ripple Kent 2011)	
<u>BLACK IPA</u>	5.8
Traditional floor malt 'Grist', comprising of Maris Otter, Munich, Oatmeal, Chocolate and Bamberg Smoked Malts. Added First Gold Hops give a full bodied balanced ale with a hint of creamy fresh chocolate and a bitter end.	
<u>ROCKIN' ROBIN</u> (Maidstone Kent 2011)	
<u>RELIANT ROBIN</u>	4.2
Auburn best bitter using four malts, EKG give traditional notes on the palate and a fresh spicy finish.

ROYAL TONBRIDGE (Royal Tonbridge Wells Kent 2010)

Golden ale brewed with German Hallertau hops. Full bodied, yet refreshing, with light caramel malts and distinctive herbal hop aromas.
